Responsive Reading

I Corinthians 15:20-28

Leader: But now Christ is risen from the dead, and has become the first-fruits of those who have fallen asleep. For since by man came death, by Man also came the resurrection of the dead.

Congregation: For as in Adam all die,
even so in Christ shall all be made alive.
But each one in his own order:
Christ the first-fruits,
afterward those who are Christ's at His coming.
Then comes the end,
when He delivers the kingdom to God the Father,
when He puts an end to all rule and all authority and power.

Leader: For He must reign till He has put all enemies under His feet. The last enemy that will be destroyed is death. For "He has put all things under His feet." But when He says "all things are put under Him," it is evident that He who put all things under Him is excepted.

Congregation: Now when all things are made subject to Him,
then the Son Himself will also be subject
to Him who put all things under Him,
that God may be all in all. AMEN

Luther's Commentary on the Second Article of the Apostles Creed

Congregation: We believe that Jesus Christ
—true God, Son of the Father from eternity,
and true Man, born of the Virgin Mary—is our Lord.
He has redeemed us, lost and condemned persons,
saved us at great cost from sin, death, and the power of the devil,
not with silver or gold, but with His holy and precious blood
and His innocent suffering and death.
All this He has done that we may be His own,
live under Him in His kingdom,
and serve Him in everlasting righteousness, innocence, and blessedness,
just as He is risen from the dead and lives and rules eternally.
This is most certainly true. AMEN
