“Holy, holy, holy, Lord God of Sabaoth;

Silent Confession followed by Corporate Confession

We confess that we have sinned against You in thought, word, and deed,  
by what we have done, and by what we have left undone.

we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves.  
We are truly sorry and we humbly repent.  
For the sake of Your Son Jesus Christ,  
have mercy on us and forgive us;  
that we may delight in Your will and walk in Your ways,  
to the glory of Your Name. **AMEN**

## Assurance of Pardon

Being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed, to demonstrate at the present time His righteousness, that He might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus. **AMEN**  
*Romans 3:24-26*

## The Scots Confession, Chapter 1
