### Revelation 4:2-8

Leader: Immediately I was in the Spirit; and behold, a throne set in heaven,  
and One sat on the throne.

**Congregation: And He who sat there was like a jasper and a sardius stone in appearance; and there was a rainbow around the throne, in appearance like an emerald.**

Leader: Around the throne were twenty-four thrones, and on the thrones I  
had saw twenty-four elders sitting, clothed in white robes; and they  
crowns of gold on their heads.

**Congregation: And from the throne proceeded lightnings, thunderings, and voices. Seven lamps of fire were burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.**
