Meditation

All Glory, Laud, and Honor

Responsive Reading: I Peter 2:9-17

Congregation: Who once were not a people but are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy. Beloved, I beg you as sojourners and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts which war against the soul,

Leader: Having your conduct honorable among the Gentiles, that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may, by your good works which they observe, glorify God in the day of visitation.

Congregation: Therefore, submit yourselves to every ordinance of man for the Lord's sake, whether to the king as supreme, or to governors, as to those who are sent by him for the punishment

of evildoers and for the praise of those who do good.

Leader: For this is the will of God, that by doing good you may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men---as free, yet not using liberty as a cloak for vice, but as bondservants of God.

Congregation: Honor all people. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honor the king. AMEN

Silent Confession followed by Corporate Confession

Leader: Let us confess our sins to Almighty God.

Congregation: Heavenly Father, eternal and merciful God, we acknowledge and

confess before Your divine majesty that we are poor, miserable sinners. But we are penitent, Lord, and we grieve because of our sins whereby we provoked Your wrath. We bring accusation against ourselves and lay transgression to our own charge. Make us bold to desire that You may, in mercy, regard our miseries. Have compassion on us, most merciful God and Father, and be pleased to forgive all our sins for the sake of the passion of Your dear Son, Jesus Christ. In His name we pray. AMEN

Assurance of Pardon

Hebrews 12:7, 28

If you endure chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom a father does not chasten? ...Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear. **AMEN**

Leader: Our sins are forgiven!

Congregation: Thanks be to God!
