**RESPONSIVE READING**

**PHILIPPIANS 2:3-11**

Leader: Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself.

**Congregation: Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.**

Leader: Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God,

**Congregation: But made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men.**

Leader: And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.

**Congregation: Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name,**

Leader: That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth,

**Congregation: And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. AMEN**

## **Confession of Sin**

For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works. **AMEN** *Titus 2:11-14*

Silent Confession followed by Corporate Confession

Leader: Let us confess our sins to Almighty God.

**Congregation: O almighty God,  
who brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus;  
we acknowledge that we are unworthy of Your redeeming grace.  
We have not believed Your promises; nor trusted in our living Lord.  
Through worldliness of spirit,  
our eyes have been kept from discerning His presence with us.  
Through disappointment of mind and dejection of spirit,  
our hearts have not burned within us as we have heard His Word.  
We have not trusted in His redeeming power,  
and have been overcome of evil.  
We have forgotten the glad tidings of His peace.  
But now in penitence we come to you, beseeching Your  
forgiveness. Mercifully grant us absolution from all our sins,  
and restore unto us the joy of Your salvation;  
for Jesus Christ's sake, our only mediator and advocate. **AMEN****

## **Assurance of Pardon**

For Christ has not entered the holy places made with hands, which are copies of the true, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us; not that He should offer Himself often, as the high priest enters the Most Holy Place every year with blood of another— He then would have had to suffer often since the foundation of the world; but now, once at the end of the ages, He has appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself. **AMEN** *Hebrews 9:24-26*

Leader: Our sins are forgiven!

**Congregation: Thanks be to God!**

1 Let us love and sing and wonder,  
 Let us praise the Savior's name!  
 He has hushed the law's loud thunder,  
 He has quenched Mount Sinai's flame:  
 He has washed us with His blood,  
 He has brought us nigh to God.

2 Let us love the Lord who bought us,  
 Pitied us when enemies,  
 Called us by His grace, and taught us,  
 Gave us ears and gave us eyes:  
 He has washed us with His blood,  
 He presents our souls to God.

3 Let us sing, though fierce temptation  
 Threaten hard to bear us down!  
 For the Lord, our strong salvation,  
 Holds in view the conqueror's crown:  
 He who washed us with His blood  
 Soon will bring us home to God.

4 Let us wonder; grace and justice  
 Join and point to mercy's store;  
 When through grace in Christ our trust is,  
 Justice smiles and asks no more:  
 He who washed us with His blood  
 Has secured our way to God.

5 Let us praise, and join the chorus  
 Of the saints enthroned on high;  
 Here they trusted Him before us,  
 Now their praises fill the sky:  
 "You have washed us with Your blood;  
 You are worthy, Lamb of God!" **AMEN**

## TRINITY HYMNAL, PAGE 846

**We believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth,  
 of all things visible and invisible.**

**And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son of God,  
 begotten of His Father before all worlds, God of God, Light of Light,  
 very God of very God, begotten, not made, being of one substance with the Father;  
 by whom all things were made;  
 who for us and for our salvation came down from heaven,  
 and was incarnate by the Holy Spirit of the virgin Mary, and was made man;  
 and was crucified also for us under Pontius Pilate; He suffered and was buried;  
 and the third day He rose again according to the Scriptures, and ascended into heaven,

 to judge both the living and the dead; whose kingdom shall have no end.**
